

MEMBERSHIP REGULATION

Applicable to the 2026 Membership Campaign

ARTICLE 1: Membership Categories

INNEXA AISBL recognises the following membership categories in accordance with the Statute of Association:

- **Event Membership**
- **Associate Membership**
- **Full Membership**

Each category provides a different level of participation in the activities, opportunities and governance of the Association.

The membership rights and opportunities associated with each category for the 2026 Membership Campaign are summarised in the **Membership Framework 2026** reproduced below, which forms an integral part of this Regulation. The Membership Framework shall be interpreted in conjunction with this Membership Regulation and the Statute. In the event of any inconsistency, the Statute shall prevail.

ARTICLE 2: Membership Fees

The annual membership fees applicable to the 2026 Membership Campaign are:

Membership Category	Membership fee 2026
Event Membership	EUR 170
Associate Membership	EUR 350/year
Full Membership	EUR 2,000/year

Participation of one representative in the Annual INNEXA Summit is included in the Associate and Full Membership. Each additional participant from the same organisation shall be subject to the applicable Event Membership fee.

ARTICLE 3: Application and Admission Procedure

- 1 Application.** The applicant downloads, completes and signs the official Membership Application available on the INNEXA AISBL website and submits it through the channel indicated by the Association.
- 2 Evaluation and decision.** Applications are evaluated by the competent body in accordance with the Statute of Association. The Board of Directors decides on Event and Associate Membership applications. Full Membership applications are evaluated by the Board of Directors and submitted to the General Assembly for the final decision.
- 3 Admission notice.** INNEXA AISBL communicates the outcome of the application in writing. Following a positive decision, the applicant receives the payment instructions and the link required to register on the INNEXA B2Match platform.
- 4 Registration and payment.** Within ten calendar days from receipt of the admission notice, the applicant must complete the registration on the INNEXA B2Match platform, pay the applicable membership fee and upload proof of payment.
- 5 Activation.** Following verification by INNEXA AISBL, the membership becomes effective, the organisation is entered into the Membership Register and access to the membership opportunities associated with the selected category is activated.

Failure to complete the procedure. If the applicant does not complete registration and payment within the ten-calendar-day period, the admission decision may lapse unless INNEXA AISBL grants a written extension.

ARTICLE 4: Membership Duration

As INNEXA AISBL was formally established during the 2026 calendar year, the first membership period shall exceptionally be extended in order to ensure that members have an adequate timeframe to participate fully in the life of the Association and benefit from the activities and opportunities promoted by INNEXA AISBL.

Accordingly, memberships activated during 2026 shall remain valid until **30 April 2027**, without any additional charge.

During this extended membership period, members shall retain access to the activities, membership opportunities and INNEXA platform associated with their respective membership category.

Event Membership is linked to the relevant event and shall remain active **until seven calendar days after its conclusion**. Access to the INNEXA platform shall be deactivated thereafter.

ARTICLE 6: Reciprocal Membership Arrangements with Partner Networks

6.1. INNEXA AISBL may establish reciprocal membership and cooperation arrangements with networks, alliances and associations that are legally constituted and whose objectives, activities and reputation are compatible with those of INNEXA AISBL.

6.2. The Board of Directors shall assess each proposed arrangement. The assessment shall consider its strategic relevance, the reputation and reliability of the partner network, the complementarity of the respective activities, the expected benefits for INNEXA AISBL and its members, the principle of reciprocity and any financial or organisational commitments involved.

6.3. Before the reciprocal arrangement is concluded, the Board of Directors shall submit it to the General Assembly for strategic endorsement. The General Assembly shall assess the arrangement within its statutory competence to determine the general policy of the Association. Such endorsement shall concern the strategic cooperation between the two organisations and, where applicable, the participation of INNEXA AISBL in the partner network. It shall not replace the formal decision concerning the admission of the partner network as a member of INNEXA AISBL.

6.4. Following the strategic endorsement of the General Assembly, the Board of Directors shall decide on the admission of the partner network as an Associate Member, in accordance with Articles 5.2 and 13.2 of the Articles of Association. The admission decision shall be reasoned and shall not be automatic.

6.5. A partner network admitted under this Article shall have the same statutory rights and obligations as any other Associate Member.

6.6. Reciprocal membership shall not, in itself, exempt the partner network from the payment of the applicable annual membership fee. Any specific fee applicable to reciprocal network arrangements shall be proposed by the Board of Directors and approved by the General Assembly within the minimum and maximum amounts established by Article 10 of the Articles of Association.

6.7. The operational terms of the reciprocal cooperation may be set out in a separate agreement or memorandum of understanding. Such agreement may regulate the reciprocal services, joint activities, communication arrangements, use of names and logos, duration and termination of the cooperation. It shall not amend the statutory rights or obligations associated with membership.

The termination of the reciprocal cooperation arrangement shall not automatically terminate membership. The continuation or termination of the Associate Membership shall be assessed in accordance with Article 8 of the Articles of Association.

ARTICLE 5: Entry into Force

This Membership Regulation was approved by the General Assembly on 20/08/2026. It enters into force on the same date and remains applicable until amended or repealed by the General Assembly.
